Special Appointing Authorities for Veterans

Veterans' Recruitment Appointment (VRA):

You may be eligible for this appointing authority if you are a disabled veteran; or veteran in receipt of a campaign badge for service during a war or in a campaign or expedition; or an Armed Forces Service Medal for participation in a military operation; or a veteran recently separated within the last 3 years and under honorable conditions (this means an honorable or general discharge).

30% or More Disabled Veteran:

Individuals who have retired from active military service with a service oriented disability rating of 30% or more; or, have an official statement, dated 1991 or later, from the Department of Veterans Affairs or from a branch of the Armed Forces certifying as having a compensable service-connected disability of 30% or more.

Veterans' Employment Opportunity Act Eligible:

You are eligible for this hiring category if you are a preference eligible or a veteran who separated from the Armed Forces under honorable conditions after substantially completing 3 or more years of active service.
